



Dear Parents and Guardians:

The City of Lake Mills Parks and Recreation Department will again provide fundamental skill building practice time opportunities coached by a paid Head and Assistant Girls Softball and Boys Baseball Coaches leading these practices. In order to accommodate everyone, the practices will again be offered at two times during the course of the week with a day time slot on most Friday mornings and an evening time slot on most Monday evenings - all in Lake Mills during late May and June. Children will be required to attend one of these mandatory practice time slots in order to play in the intramural games on Tuesday and Wednesday evenings. Of course, the children may attend both practices if they wish but one will be mandatory in order to play in the intramural games.

A fee of \$15 will be required to participate in the program and the fee will jump to \$20 if one registers late. **We are requiring an early registration** so the number of sponsors can be determined and their sponsored tee shirts may be ordered - as soon as possible. Those signing up late may not be guaranteed a spot on any team as we want to keep the team numbers small enough so each child will get an adequate amount of playing time!

The Department of Parks and Recreation or the practice coaches will inform the participants of the first practice time and the sponsored team they are on. The volunteer coaches will distribute the shirts and handle all communication of game cancellations or diamond changes. If practice should be cancelled due to inclement weather, listen to KIOW 107.3 FM as the practice coaches and Rec. Department will not be expected to call everyone.
