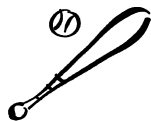

RULES:

*Individuals in street clothes may enter free charge as long as they are accompanying a child. Persons not paying to enter must stay out of the water!

*Non-appropriate (suggestive) attire is not allowed at the center. White tee shirts are allowed to be worn over a swimming suit.

*All trash must be put in the trash receptacles.

*Concessions will be for sale from 11am—

8:30pm daily

*A family swim is: parent(s), children, grandparent(s), aunt(s), uncle(s) and cousin(s). A friend staying the night with a child is welcome to come to “family night” but please do not abuse this privilege.

*All food must be consumed in the food court and that food must be purchased at the aquatic center.

*Only water is allowed to drink on the deck.

*Children unaccompanied by an adult during open swim hours must have completed level 3 **and at least** be entering the 2nd grade.

*3 meter high board is for persons who are at least 10 yrs. of age and have passed the deep end test.

*Individuals 18 & over do not have to pass the deep end test but use discretion.

*Arm flotation devices are not recommended but may be used by preschoolers in the zero depth area only.

*Additional general rules apply; no running on deck & no diving in shallow water.

(The Parks and Recreation Department has the right to change any of these rules at any time and Aquatic Center Staff has the right to ask anyone to leave the deep water if they feel an individual is struggling.)
